

UNIVERSITY HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

The University of Reading was awarded its charter in 1926. It is a research-intensive university of international standing. There are currently 22,000 students from over 180 different nations and over 4,000 members of staff.

The University of Reading is based on three main UK campuses: London Road, Whiteknights in Reading and Greenlands campus in Henley. It has overseas campuses in Malaysia and South Africa, and our staff and students work world-wide as part

- Leadership by the senior management team to encourage a safety culture, and to check that policies and procedures are implemented
